



WASH CARE





The following guidelines will help you gain longevity from your garment.

Skirts/ Trouser/Shorts

- Wash at 40 C. Higher temperatures will cause shrinkage, affect the color, or weaken the fibers. Wash dark colors separately. Avoid strong fabric conditioners as they can break the fibers. Do not bleach.
- Do not tumble dry pleated garments as the pleats will disappear. For best results simply drip dry after washing.
- If you want to improve the creases, use a steam iron or a clean damp cloth, with a regular iron. Do not
 use a hot iron directly on the garment.

Skirt-Blouses

- Can be machine washed on a gentle polyester/easy care/delicate program up to 40 C. Avoid strong fabric conditioners. Do not bleach.
- These shorts do dry very quickly if left to dry naturally, but if you want to tumble dry them ensure they are on a cool setting.
- Ironing is not necessary for these shorts. However if you want to iron, use a cool iron setting and
 place a clean damp cloth between the garment and the iron. Do not iron directly on to the
 garment and do not use excessive heat as this makes the fabric brittle. Do not iron on the print or
 Embroidery directly please iron on reverse.

SHOE CARE - BLACK

- Simply remove excess dirt with a cloth and/ or a brush and apply the cream shoe polish never liquid shine evenly to your shoes.
- Make it a point to polish your shoes once in 2 days to restore the appearance of your shoes.
- Store your shoes using a shoe tree, this will help the shoe retain its shape. If you don't have a shoe
 tree, stuff the toe cap with newspaper or tissue.
- Never store shoes near direct heat.

* KINDLY NOTE THAT ANY PRINTS / LOGOS / EMBELLISHMENTS MUST NOT BE IRONED ON DIRECTLY BUT INSTEAD ON THE REVERSE.
