Foundation Stage Admission Process

Registration and admission for the academic year 2020-21 is done through online through the school website. Foundation Stage admissions will be done through a 'Playdate' session to observe the children to understand each child's starting point to support individual need of him/her.

Admission Requirements:

Foundation Stage 1

For admission to Foundation Stage 1, the child must be 3 years old as on 31st December 2020. (2017/2016 Born child)

Foundation Stage 2

For admission to Foundation Stage 2, the child must be 4 years old as on 31st December 2020.(2016/2015 born child)

Step 1 – Online Registration

- Select 'Enroll Now' under the 'Admission' tab on the home page of The Apple International School <http://apple.sch.ae/>
- Complete the Online Enquiry form.
- Once you complete the form, you will receive an acknowledgement with an online enquiry number

Step 2 – Registration

- You will receive the email to pay an **Application fee of AED 500 (non-refundable)** online or by visiting the school to initiate the registration process.

Note: Payment of the registration fee does not guarantee your child a place at school. Your application will only be completed once we have received all documentation and the required payment.

Step 3 – ‘Playdate’ Session

- You will be invited by the School Registrar for a ‘Playdate’ session to **observe** the child’s starting point
- Parents are required to provide listed documents to complete the application process. Please note you are requested to bring all the documents required when your bringing your child for the ‘Playdate’ session.
- Complete your registration and make transport arrangements to proceed the child for the observation session.

Step 4 – Enrollment

- Registrar will be sending offer letters to successful candidates, subject to seat availability.
- The seat will be reserved only after the payment of First Term academic fees is paid within Ten days of offer letter is sent.
- After the above process, students are officially enrolled.

Note:

If a seat is not available, your child’s application will be placed on a waitlist upon successful application until a seat becomes available.

Documents required:

- 1. 1 Passport Copy of the child and the parents.**
- 2. 1 Visa copy of the child and the parents.**
- 3. 1 Emirates id copy of the child and parents**
- 4. Vaccination Card Copy of the child**
- 5. Birth Certificate copy of the child**
- 6. 5 latest Photos**
- 7. Health Form duly filled (Can be collected from School’s reception)**
