

**STUDENT BUS BEHAVIOUR CODE**

Students are expected to adhere to this Bus Behavior Code. Let us work together to keep everyone safe and happy, on the journey to and going home from school. Parents discussing these standards with their child at home will be very helpful!

Things To Do:

- Wear a face mask at all times.
- Listen to the Bus Guardian for Temperature Checks.
- Only travel on your designated bus.
- Be ready and on time for pick up and departure.
- Make sure the road is safe before crossing the street.
- Avoid danger zone areas which surrounds all sides of the bus.
- Maintain at least 10 steps away from the bus and make sure the Driver can see you.
- Be courteous and follow the Bus Guardian and Driver's instructions.
- Scan your ID card when boarding and leaving the bus.
- Only sit in the marked designated bus seat as advised by the Bus Guardian.
- Wear the seat belt for the entire journey.
- Remain seated until advised by the Bus Guardian.
- Sit facing forward at all times.
- Keep the aisles and walkway clear at all times.
- If feeling unwell, immediately report to the Bus Guardian or Driver.
- Take your personal items with you when leaving the bus.
- Use electronic devices responsibly and report any misuse to your Bus Guardian or Driver.

Things Not To Do:

- Stand while the bus is moving.
- Sit on a seat labelled as restricted.
- Distract the Driver.
- Throw objects of any kind on the bus.
- Shout or be disrespectful towards others.
- Damage the bus in any way.
- Bring friends onto the bus without written permission from STS and the School.
- Place anything outside the windows of the bus.
- Eat or drink (except water) on the bus.
